He shall build an house for my name, and I will stablish the throne of his kingdom for ever... thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee.”</p> <p>2 Samuel 7:12-13 (KJV) (See also Isaiah 9:6-7)</p>	<p>“I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son.”</p> <p>2 Samuel 7:14</p> <p>“He shall cry to me, ‘You are my Father, my God, and the Rock of my salvation.’ And I will make him the firstborn, the highest of the kings of the earth.”</p> <p>(Psalm 89:26-27; See also Isa. 9:6-7)</p>	<p><b>JOB</b> – “my Redeemer lives, and at the last he will stand upon the earth...after my skin has been thus destroyed, yet in my flesh I shall see God...”</p> <p>Job 19:25-27</p> <p><b>DANIEL</b> – “And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life...”</p> <p>Daniel 12:2</p> <p><b>ISAIAH</b> – “Your dead shall live; their bodies shall rise...the earth will give birth to the dead.”</p> <p>Isaiah 26:19</p>

It does not say, “And to offsprings,” referring to many, but referring to one, “And to your offspring,” who is Christ.”</p> <p>Galatians 3:16</p>	<p>“for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ... And if you are Christ’s, then you are Abraham’s offspring, heirs according to promise.”</p> <p>Galatians 3:26-29</p> <p>“Nor by the earth; for it is his footstool: neither by Jerusalem; for it is the city of the great King.”</p> <p>Matthew 5:35</p>	<p>“And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus.
